

# What does 321 Auto Mart Do With Your Personal Information?

## Who is providing this notice?

321 Auto Mart.

## Why?

Financial companies choose how they share their personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some, but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

## What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social security number and information we receive on an application for credit;
- and information about your transactions with us and others;
- and information we receive from a credit reporting agency.

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

## How?

All financial companies need to share nonpublic, personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their nonpublic information; the reasons 321 Auto Mart, chooses to share; and where you can limit this sharing.

<b>What we do</b>	
How does 321 Auto Mart protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We restrict access to your personal information to only those employees who need to know that information to do business.
How does 321 Auto Mart collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Finance or lease a vehicle</li> <li>- Apply for credit</li> <li>- Purchase a service</li> <li>- Provide your driver's license</li> <li>- Provide your social security number</li> </ul> We will also collect personal information if you apply for employment.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes, such as information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>- affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>- sharing your nonaffiliated to market to you.</li> </ul> State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

<b>Definitions</b>	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non financial companies.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

*Additionally, 321 Auto Mart will collect your personal information when you provide documentation necessary to complete a transaction such as proof of income, proof of employment or affiliation, proof of residency, personal references, court papers, insurance card, etc. Furthermore, we will collect personal information should you default on a payment or violate the terms of the transaction.*
